9. What did Elisha tell Gehazi to do with his staff when the Shunammite woman's son died?
10. What important lesson do we learn from the story of Naaman? (It is something we must do if we want to be saved from death).
11. What did Jonah tell the sailors when they woke him up during the storm?
12. What was the feast that Hezekiah asked all Israel to come to?
13. What did the High Priest find in the Temple when Josiah commanded it to be cleaned?
14. Why did God bless Daniel and his friends?
