6. What will happen to the dead people who have loved and obeyed God when Jesus comes back to the earth to set up God's kingdom?
7. What did Jesus say to the wind and the waves when the disciples awoke him?
8. Why was Jairus sad when he came to Jesus?
9. Among that great crowd of people, only a young lad had some food. What did he have?
10. Finish these words of Jesus, "I am the light...."
11. Who is the Good Shepherd?
12. What did the younger son decide to do when he was feeding the pigs?
13. What does the word 'resurrection' mean?
14. What did Zacchaeus do when he wanted to see Jesus?

(d) What did the ruler of the feast say when he tasted the wine?
3. (a) What happened when Peter tried to walk on the water to Jesus?
(b) Why did Peter begin to sink into the water?
