4. What happened to Ananias and Sapphira when they told lies to the apostles?
5. God does not live in temples made by men. Where does God live?
6. What did the Ethiopian Eunuch do when they came to some water by the side of the road?
7. What will Jesus do for people who have believed him when he returns?
8. Cornelius was a kind man and he prayed to God. But what more did he have to do to be saved?
9. Whom did Paul and Barnabas always preach the Gospel to first?
10. Some of the Jews did not want to hear what Paul and Barnabus were teaching. Whom did Paul say they were going to teach the Gospel to now?
11. What did Paul say to his friends after he had been hurt at Lystra?
12. What were Paul and Silas doing at midnight in the prison?
13. Paul stayed with a tent-maker and his wife at Corinth. What were their names?
14. A lot of people believed the Gospel in Ephesus. Some of them had books about magic. What did they do with them?
