8. Elisha stayed with the kind woman of Shunem. What did Elisha say the lady would be given because of her kindness?
9. What happened to the son of the Shunammite woman when he went out to his father to the reapers?
10. Why did God want Jonah to go to Nineveh?
11. What did Jonah do instead of obeying God?
12. What did Hezekiah do as soon as he became King?
