DIVISION 13 or 14

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Please note:

- a) Divisions 13 or 14 include scholars who reach the age of 13 or 14 respectively on or before 31/12/00. (The year that Stage 4 lessons commenced).
- b) Scholars must record their division (ie.13 or 14 - not both), age and allocated examination number on each sheet.
- c) Make certain that the section and question number are recorded in the left hand margin of each sheet.
- d) Leave a space between each answer. 2-3 lines.
- e) The suggested time for each section is a guide only. The total time for the examination is limited to 90 minutes plus an allowance for completing the paragraph started before time was up. One or two sentences would be a reasonable allowance to complete the paragraph. The 90 minutes commences when the Superintendent is satisfied that the scholars have had sufficient opportunity to read the questions and receive any explanations and answers to queries.

SECTION 'A' - 8 QUESTIONS: (7 marks each) Suggested time 50 minutes

One paragraph only is required to answer each question in this section.

1. Briefly explain why baptism is so important.
2. Describe what happened when Jesus asked his disciples to row out and cast their nets once again.
3. What does Jesus say about self-control in the Sermon on the Mount?
4. What happened when Jesus wanted solitude in a desert place after the death of John the Baptist?
5. What was the purpose of the Transfiguration and what lesson does this contain for us?
6. How is the love of God shown in the parable of the Lost Son?
7. What were the differences between the "wise" and "foolish" virgins?
8. How important is belief in the resurrection of Christ?

SECTION 'B' - 2 QUESTIONS (22 marks each) Suggested time 40 minutes.

Essay type answers are required for these questions.

*Select and answer **two questions only** from the following.*

1. Briefly describe the character of the saint as outlined in the Beatitudes.
2. Describe the parable of the sower and show the lessons that Jesus taught in it.
3. Describe the process by which Jesus led Martha to a full faith in himself as the source of life and salvation.
4. Show how Christ's trial, death and burial fulfilled Messianic prophecies.
